GOLD-COAST-CUP 2009

International Figure Skating Competition

Küsnacht ZH, Switzerland, 8.-11. October 2009



1. General

The Eislaufclub Küssnacht ZH, under the authorization of Swiss Ice Skating, is organising the first **"GOLD-COAST-CUP 2009"**: an International Figure Skating Competition (ISU Rule 107.12) for clubs with the following events:

- Chick, Novice, Junior and Senior in Single Skating (Ladies/Men),
- Novice and Junior in Ice Dance.

This competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2008, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single Skating and Ice Dance 2008 as well as the relevant ISU Communications.

(Covered rink, 60m x 30m)

The town of Küssnacht ZH is located on the famous "Gold Coast" by the lake of Zürich, and is situated just at 8km from Zurich-City. Zurich is an international venue which is easily accessible by plane and train. Getting to Küssnacht by public transportation is very easy. Train lines S-6 and S-16 leave just 80m from the hotels of Küssnacht every 15 minutes to Zurich and every 30 minutes directly to the airport.

2. Technical data:

According to the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single Skating and Ice Dance 2008 - and updated.

2.1. Single Skating:

Senior: Ladies and Men born before 01.07.1995

Short Program: 2 min. 50 sec. max.

Free Program: Ladies 4 min. (+/- 10 sec)

Men 4 min. 30 sec. (+/- 10 sec)

NB: Gold-test reached for Swiss skaters

Junior: Ladies and Men born between 01.07.1990 – 30.06.1996

Short Program: 2 min. 50 sec. max.
Free Program: Ladies 3 min. 30 sec. (+/- 10 sec)
Men 4 min. (+/- 10 sec)

NB: Gold-test reached for Swiss skaters or to be in the national Swiss team (SEV-Kader-Elite und-Junioren)

Novice U15: Girls and Boys born between 01.07.94 – 30.06.1999
(according ISU Communication n°1397 -and updated)

Short Program: 2 min. 30 sec. max
Free Program: Girls 3 min. (+/- 10 sec)
Boys 3 min. 30 sec. (+/- 10 sec).

NB: Intergold-test reached for Swiss skaters

Novice U13: Girls and Boys born between 01.07.96 – 30.06.1999
(according ISU Communication n°1397 -and updated)

Free Program only: Girls 3 min. (+/- 10 sec)
Boys 3 min. 30 sec. (+/- 10 sec).

NB: Silber-test reached for Swiss skaters

Chick U10: Girls and Boys born after 01.07.1999

Free Program only: Girls and Boys 3 min. (+/- 10 sec)

a) Maximum of 6 jump elements one of which must be an Axel type jump and there may be up to three (3) jump combinations or sequences. Only one jump combination can contain three (3) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted. Only two (2) jumps with two and a half (2 1/2) revolutions or three (3) revolutions can be repeated either in a jump combination or a jump sequence.

b) There must be a maximum of three (3) spins of a different nature, one of which must be a spin combination (minimum of ten (10) revolutions) and one a spin with only one position (minimum of six (6) revolutions). In spins the minimum number of revolutions required in a position is two (2). In case this requirement is not fulfilled, the position is not counted. The number of changes of foot in the spin combination is optional.

c) A maximum of 1 step sequence or 1 spiral sequence.

Deduction: -0.5 by fall Coefficient for components: Boys and Girls: 1.2

NB: Bronze-test reached for Swiss skaters

For all the categories: no restriction by test for the skaters who are members of the EC Küsnacht ZH.

2.2. Ice Dance:

Novice:	Girls born between 01.07.1994 – 30.06.1999 Boys born between 01.07.1992 – 30.06.1999
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Compulsory Dance:	Rocker Foxtrot, Paso Doble
Free Dance:	3 min (+/- 10. sec)

Junior:	Ladies born between 01.07.1990 –30.06.1996 Men born between 01.07.1988 – 30.06.1996
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Compulsory Dance:	Argentine Tango
Original Dance:	2 min. 30 sec. (+/- 10 sec) Folk/Country Dance
Free Dance:	3 min. 30 (+/- 10 sec.)

3. Entries:

All clubs which are members of National Figure Skating Federations associated with the ISU are invited to take part in the competition. Each club may enter a maximum of two (2) competitors in each category (no limit for Ice Dance). In case of too many entries, the organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants. The EC Küssnacht reserves the right to enter more competitors in each category.

Each club can enter too:

- one (1) International or ISU Championship Judge for Figure Skating
- one (1) International or ISU Championship Judge for Ice Dance
- one (1) International or ISU Technical Controller
- one (1) International or ISU Technical Specialist

In case of too many entries, panels and judges will be drawn on **10.09.2009**. Afterwards a written confirmation will be sent to each club.

4. Deadline for entries:

The entry-form for competitors, judges, technical controllers, technical specialists, coaches, team-leaders and the "Planned Program Content Sheet" for each competitor must reach the organizer by **10.09.2009** at the following address:

5. Charges:

After the deadline, an invoice will be sent to each club entered: a charge of € 50.-- has to be paid for each single competitor entered and € 75.-- for each ice dance couple entered at the accreditation before the competition.

6. Expenses:

Travel expenses, accommodation and meals, are at the charge of all participants.

The organizer will provide accommodation and meals for judges drawn for the panel, technical controllers, technical specialists, data and video operators from Thursday, 08.10.2009, starting with dinner, to Sunday, 11.10.2009, ending with lunch.

7. Liability:

In accordance with Rule 119 the organizer accepts no liability for injuries or damages incurred by competitors or officials or anybody. The organizer will provide Medical Emergency Aid during the competition.

8. Music:

Music will be reproduced from a CD-player. CD's must have the full name of the competitor, club and category in which the competitor is entered. CD's must be handed over to the organizer immediately at the registration.

9. Calculation of results:

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single Skating and Ice Dance 2008, Rule 352, will be in place in all categories.

10. Awards:

The three best competitors of each event will be awarded with cups. All other competitors will receive a medal.

11. Accreditation/Office:

The accreditation will start at 13.00 on Thursday, 08.10.2009. The office of the organizing committee will be located at the ice rink and will be opened every day during the hours of the competition.

12. Opening draw:

The opening draw will take place at 18.00 on Thursday, 08.10.2009 in the Restaurant of the ice rink.
